

# How to get to Bayer Ltd, Sandyford

# BY CAR

## From the M50 South Bound

- Take the Sandyford/Dundrum exit from the M50 - Exit 13
- Take the third turn off the roundabout towards Sandyford and continue along this road which runs parallel to the M50 (South Bound)
- Take the slip road off to the left and get into the right hand lane ready to turn right at the cross roads

## North Bound

- Take the Sandyford exit to the M50
- Cross the bridge over the M50 Turn left at the next set of traffic lights (at the roundabout) and get into the right hand side lane

## Continuing from M50 from both directions

- At the next set of traffic lights turn right, ("Beacon Hotel" on your right) into Blackthorn Road
- Continue along this road, passing one traffic light until you reach set of lights with blinking amber light (grey Avid building on your left)
- Take next left immediately after the light into Carmanhall Road and next right into the Arkle Road
- Bayer Ltd Office is in the Block A of Microsoft building, which is the second white building on the right. Entrance to the Car Park is at the block A also on the right

## Coming from the N11 (Southbound towards Bray - from the City centre)

- Follow the N11 southbound through Donnybrook and Stillorgan
- After passing the Stillorgan Park Hotel (on the left) and the Stillorgan village junction, turn right at the next lights (St John of God hospital on the left hand side) onto Brewery Road
- At the end of Brewery Road, take the fourth exit off the roundabout, heading into the Sandyford Industrial Estate
- At the T-junction at the end of this road, (grey Avid building in front of you) turn right onto Blackthorn Road and immediately left into the Carmanhall Road
- Take next right into Arkle Road
- Bayer Ltd Office is in the Block A of Microsoft building, which is the second white building on the right. Entrance to the Car Park is at the block A also on the right

## Coming from the N11 (Northbound towards Dublin)

- Follow the N11 towards Dublin
- After passing Foxrock Church (on the right), at the next traffic lights turn left - onto Leopardstown Road
- At the end of Leopardstown Road (Racecourse on your left) take 3rd exit off the roundabout, heading into the Sandyford Industrial Estate
- At the T-junction at the end of this road, (grey Avid building in front of you) turn right onto Blackthorn Road and immediately left into the Carmanhall Road
- Take next right into Arkle Road
- Bayer Ltd Office is in the Block A of Microsoft building, which is the second white building on the right. Entrance to the Car Park is at the block A also on the right



### **By Luas from Dublin City Center to Sandyford**

Take the Green Luas Line from St. Stephens Green to Sandyford. Bayer Ltd Office is a five minute walk from here along Carmanhall Road.

### **By Dart from Dublin City Centre to Sandyford**

From the Bus Station across Butt Bridge turn left to Tara Street Station (entrance under Railway Bridge) and taking the south bound train to Blackrock. There is a bus station right outside the Dart Station; there you can get the 114 or 115 bus to Sandyford getting off at Carmanhall Road.

### **From the City Centre by bus to Sandyford**

From O'Connell Street to Sandyford take the no 5 to Sandyford getting off at Carman Hall Road (bus stops right outside our Atrium Building) , The no 11/11A to Sandyford getting off at Carmanhall Road (bus stops right outside our Atrium Building) (This bus originates in Drumcondra near the Skylon Hotel and passes through Dorset St and Parnell Sq.)

### **By Bus from Heuston Station to Sandyford**

Iarnrod Eireann operates a regular shuttle service to the central bus station in the city centre. From there it is a five minute walk across Butt Bridge turning right up Burgh Quay and left onto Hawkins Street where you can get the 44C bus to Sandyford getting off at Corrig Road. Or from the bus station walk under the railway bridge with the Customs House on you left and up Abbey Street to O'Connell Street and take the No. 5 or 11/11A bus getting off at Carmanhall Road. (bus stops right outside our Atrium Building)
